



#NoMuslimBanEver (Band Together) Vigil

Date: October 9th, 2017 **Time:** 6:00p.m. to 8:00p.m.

On October 10, the Supreme Court was expected to hear oral arguments on whether the "Muslim Ban" violates the Establishment Clause and Equal Protection Clause of the United States Constitution. However, earlier this week, the Supreme Court removed oral arguments from its calendar and asked for additional briefing from the parties.

The Muslim Ban, in all of its forms and version is discriminatory, unconstitutional and inhumane in the same vein as the Chinese Exclusion Act, the Japanese American incarceration, and special registration after 9/11.

The addition of non-Muslim majority countries to the ban, namely North Korea and Venezuela, does not negate its inherent anti-Muslim intent. It also affirms the white supremacist, exclusionary policies of the Trump administration that discriminate on the basis of faith, national origin, and immigration status.
