Tri-Valley Cultural Jews will be hosting a three part speaker series highlighting Jews in various countries around the world. The presentations will take place in different restaurants in the



Book Review AN ATHEIST STRANGER IN A STRANGE RELIGIOUS LAND Selected Writings from the Bible Belt By Herb Silverman

Herb Silverman is the founder of the Secular Coalition of America. He wrote this book as a sequel to his first book: <u>Candidate Without a Prayer</u>. This book describes his 1990 run for governor of South Carolina, mainly to challenge this states unconstitutional ban on secular persons holding public office. He was unsuccessful in this endeavor, (he is a mathematician, not a politician) but succeeded getting the ban overturned. He was asked what he would do if in the unlikely event he won the election. He famously stated that he would "demand a recount."

In the <u>latest book</u> he discusses subjects such as, Atheism, separation of church and state, Fox News, prayer in schools, presidential politics, etc. The author enables us to reaffirm our secular beliefs, while showing respect and sensitivity to those with religious beliefs.
