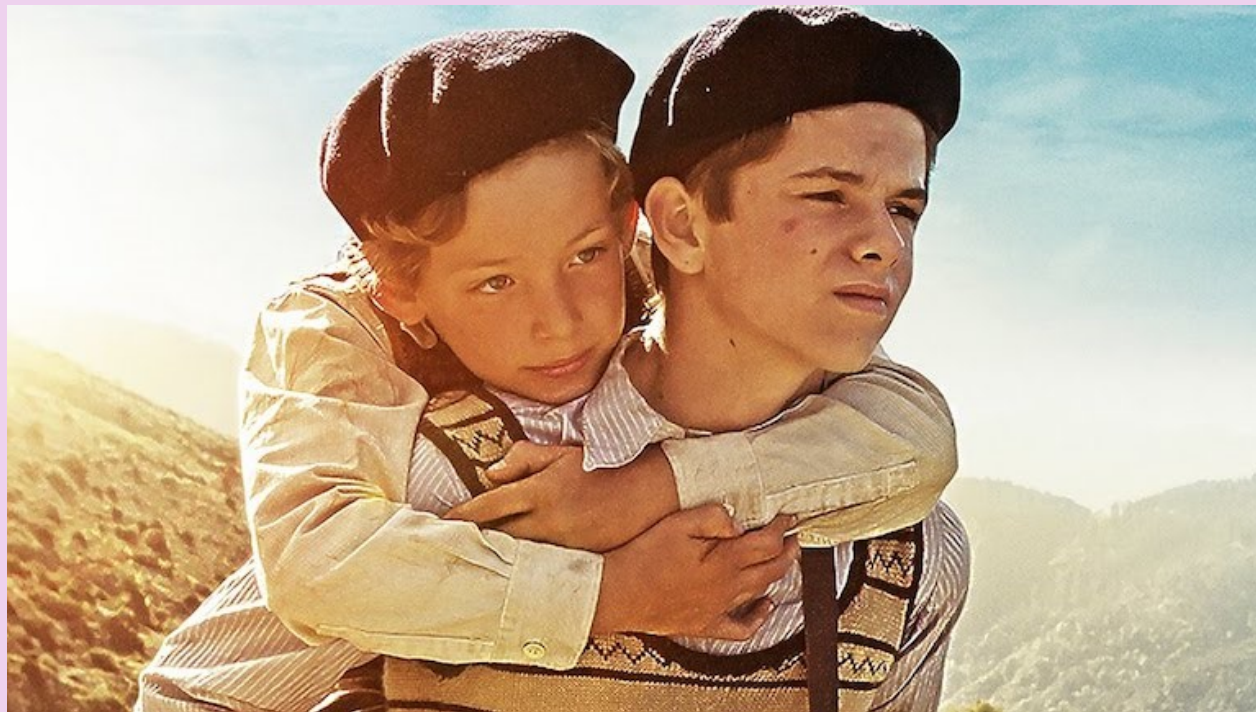

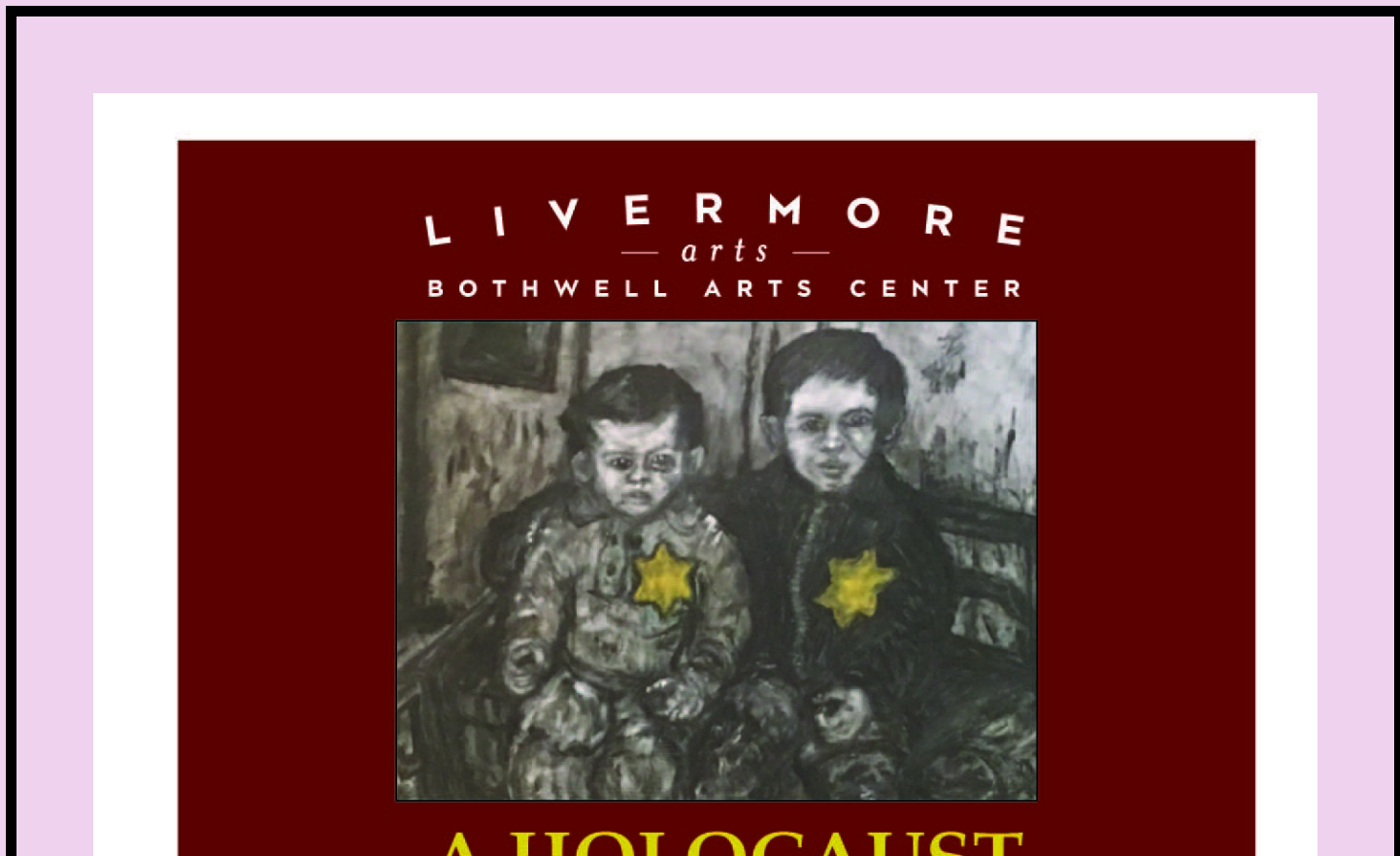




TuB'Shvat
