# Hike with Us! Urban Stairways Hike Through Oakland

Date: Saturday, August 10, 2019

Time: 10:00a.m.

If time permits, we can join for lunch afterward at Crepevine on College Ave in Oakland.

There are over 400 little-known staircases and pathways that wind up the East Bay landscape. These were originally built as shortcuts for an influx of hillside residents to get to streetcars post–1906 earthquake. We'll explore some of these staircases on a challenging 3 to 4-mile urban loop hike through Upper Rockridge. Oakland will be much cooler than the Tri-Valley area, so this will be a great way to get your steps in without overheating.

<u>Click here to see a map of the loop we'll make</u>. The route begins at Broadway and Brookside Avenue, covering a total of eleven pathways and staircases, climbing 800 feet through a mix of century-old homes and modern mansions. The views of the bay are spectacular!

There is free street parking alongside Brookside Ave, in between Broadway and Eustice Ave., across from the College Preparatory School. Carpooling is encouraged. For mapping purposes, you can use 6155 Brookside Ave, Oakland, CA 94618.



#### **BOOK REVIEW**

A BACKPACK, A BEAR, AND EIGHT CRATES OF VODKA

In his memoir the author tells of his life as a Jewish boy in Russia before the breakup of the Soviet Union and his family's escape. It describes the family's odyssey through Vienna and Paris onto eventual settlement in New York. He tells of coming from a safe middle class life in Russia to poverty and peril on the dangerous journey. Impending pogroms and changes in attitudes toward Jews in Russia necessitated their departure. He recounts the hostility as well as the generosity of individuals he encounters in Russia and on the journey to escape. As an adult, he attempts to retrace his steps in order to thank those who helped, as well as to search for his true identity.
